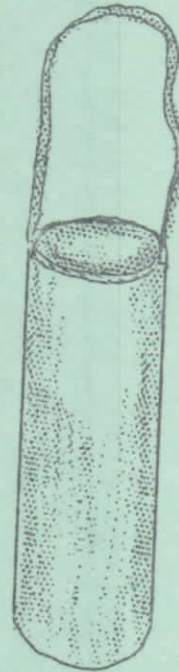
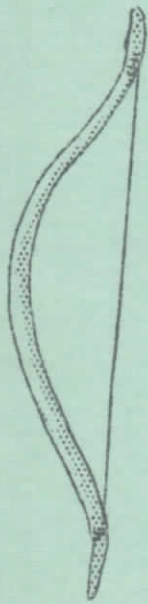

The bow was made of wood. The string was cut from animal skin.

The arrow was about as big around as a pencil. For war the arrow head was made of metal - mostly iron.

The quiver was carried on the shoulder. It is like a small golf bag. The quiver held the arrows.
