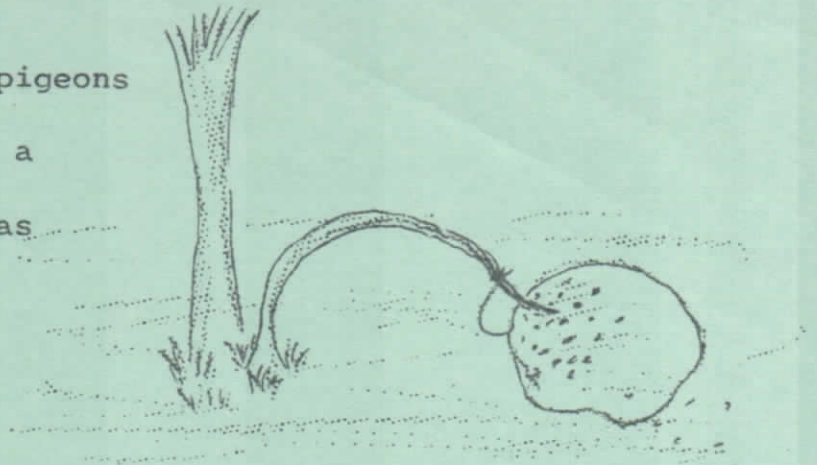


Partridges, quail and pigeons were often caught by making a bird snare. A bird snare was made this way -



Bend over a young tree. Fasten it loosely to the ground. Fasten a noose to this end of the twig. Scatter food around the twig and noose. Fix this so that a bird eating the food will pull and scratch around the twig. He will loosen the end of the twig fastened to the ground. The young tree will fly up straight and tighten the noose around the bird. The bird will be caught.
