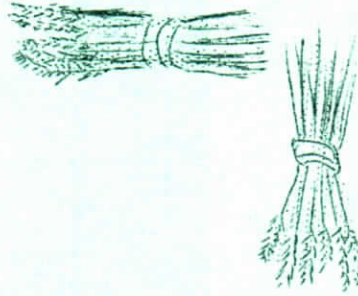

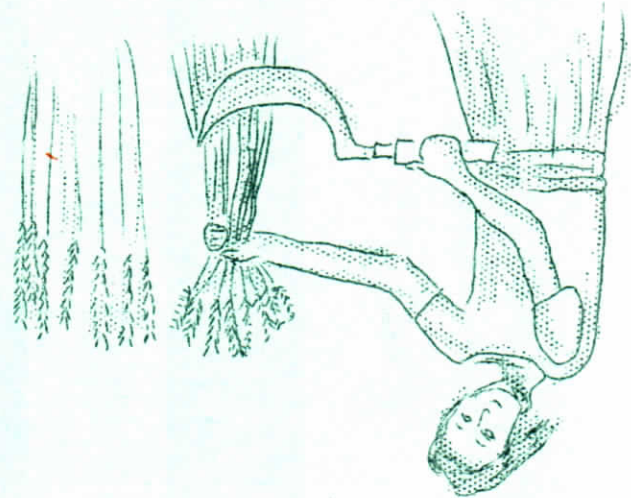


It looked like this -
