

After the fig, the most common fruit tree in Israel is the apricot.

The apricot tree grows on the terraced hillsides and along the Jordan River. It grows to be a tall tree.

The blossoms are white, pink, or red. They come early when the rains begin to stop.

This fruit is sometimes called the "golden apple."
