Quarterly Report : JANUARY – APRIL 2016

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

We are so grateful to the Lord for the start of our year 2016 with all the blessings and opportunities He has given to us. We are so excited and fired up, together with the whole church, for the lined-up back-to-back events we're going to have this first quarter of the year. We're having our Annual Missions Conference, City and Town – Wide Tent Revival Campaigns, Medical Missions, School and Prison Crusades, and Youth Camp. Above all, we're very much excited for the God's working and provision.

JANUARY

- **Annual Missions Conference**

Every year, the church is getting excited to be a blessing once more to our supported missionaries and their families, and be blessed and reminded once more of our commitment to give to missions. Also, every Sunday school department is given an opportunity to select a country of their choice to represent in terms of costume, food, booth, and singing a song with the country's language. We had our 17 missionaries and their families invited and the church gave out barongs to Pastors, dresses to Pastor's wives, toys and materials to their kids, and a basket of groceries. It was truly a joyful fellowship.

- **Medical Mission**

It was a great opportunity for the our church' medical group to team up with Pastor Angelito Tiansay of Bible Baptist Church – Cambarus, Pontevedra for a medical mission. We were able to consult 30 adults and 35 kids in total. However, sharing to them about Jesus was our primary goal, and a total of 25 professions of faith were made that morning. Glory to God!

FEBRUARY

- **24th Annual City – Wide Tent Revival Campaign**

We had this event on February 1 – 3, 2016 at our church compound every night. The church compound is packed with jeepney and buses every night and in spite of rain showers, people still came over to listen. Every night, multitudes are trusting Christ as their Saviour and we had a total of 1,349 souls that professed of accepting Jesus Christ as their Lord and personal Saviour. Praise be unto God! It was a tremendous working of the Holy Spirit in the hearts of every listener. During mornings, we hosted a Pastor's Conference and about 40 Pastors came over to listen and be challenged by our guest speakers, Dr. Jeff Wilson of Friendship Missionary Baptist Church and Bro. Andrew McCay of Middle Tennessee Baptist Church. Also, we were able to go to schools and prisons to share Jesus Christ to them. We went to 7 schools and 2 prison places, and we had about 500 students and 40 inmates who accepted Jesus as their Lord and Saviour. Truly, to God be the glory!

- **Youth Sunday and Banquet**

This is one of the most awaited events of our young ones in the church. It is their time to take charge during the service and invite their fellow young ones to attend in our church. We had 20 first time visitors and 11 souls got saved that Sunday morning service. Then, everyone got ready for the night's Youth Banquet having England culture and costume as their motif. Youth Banquet is one the Youth Council's way of raising funds for the upcoming Annual Baptist Youth Camp and they were able to sold 200 tickets, and was able to raise P12,000 more out of that banquet. We enjoyed the fellowship.

- **Revival and Evangelistic Night in Abundant Life Ministry, Metropolitan Bible Baptist Church - Silay, and Bible Baptist Mission - Sipalay**

We had a revival night in Abundant Life, one of the church' ministries, with Pastor Daniel White and his group. We were packed with about 92 people in the place and 11 souls got saved out from our first time visitors. Then the following night, we held an evangelistic night at Metropolitan Bible Baptist Church - Silay City of Pastor Jose Rodolfo "Jojo" Santos. We had about 350 - 400 in number, and glory to God for the 150 souls that got saved that night. After that, we traveled to one of our mission works in Sipalay City, Negros Occidental under the leadership of Pastor Joeven Espartero. We had about 150 people who came over and listen and 27 professions of faith were made. We are truly thankful to God for such great opportunities that He is continually giving to us, to our beloved Pastor and to our church. We're blessed beyond measure.

- **Medical Mission**

We also held a medical mission at Bible Baptist Mission - Sipalay City and our doctors were able to consult 40 adult patients and 49 pediatric patients. However, sharing Jesus happened first before consultation to our 85 patients who came early in the church, and 24 souls got saved! Amen!

MARCH

- **Evangelistic Night in Camp Canaan, Caliling, Cauayan**

We were able to gather about 200 people on our campsite to share Jesus Christ unto them. On that night, about 80 souls got saved! To God be the glory!

- **28th Commencement Exercise of Precious Jewels Kinder School**

We praise God for the 28 years that He has entrusted our church for this kinder school. On our 28th year, we had 5 kinder student graduates and 6 nursery students recognized. We thank the Lord for this ministry, that we were able to reach and held bible studies to each and every homes of our pupils. In line with that, we had about 10 parents who accepted Jesus as their Lord and Saviour.

APRIL

- **24th Annual Baptist Youth Revival Camp**


This is the most awaited event of our youth department, together with other youth groups of our fellowshipping churches. In our church, we had a goal of 350 young people to bring in our camp, and we were able to exceed or surpass it for bringing 420 of them to the camp. Amen! He truly works in mysterious ways that man cannot fathom. All in all, together with other churches, we were able to bring about 760 young people to join the camp. We had Pastor Scott Gray to challenge and fire up our young ones and we greatly joyful to see a great number of them taking a step of commitment, and giving

their lives to submit and follow God's will. My Pastor assigned me to head this event, and I'm truly grateful for that opportunity given. There were about 200 souls that got saved during the camp and 20 that decided to surrender their lives in full-time service. Out from this camp, our church has already baptized 22 young people and a total of 92 young people from our church and fellowshipping churches. To God be the glory!

These are the ministries that we've been helping, supporting, and working with as a couple together with our beloved Pastor, Dr. Edgar B. Nono. Also, I am in-charge and the present dean in our Philippine Bible Baptist College having 12 students in total number. We have 4 First Year students, 4 Second Year students, 2 in Third Year, and 2 as well in Fourth Year. Amongst the 12, 4 of them are Bible Woman, and the rest are our future Preachers, Pastors or Missionaries. We have the best batch of students this school year and we thank God for that. They took a big part of share in reaching out people, following them up, and bringing people in church especially on our big tent revival nights. We were able to recognize and gave awards to those outstanding students who were able to reach their goals during our tent meetings and youth camp. We're praying for more aspirants this opening of classes and that our 12 students would still be committed to come back and stand firm to their calling.
