patients at Hamad Hospital. Most of the patients here doesn't have relatives to care for them and it's an opportunity for us to be a good Samaritan to them. Artemeo & his wife (Malou), Alan and his son (Al John), & Ruel, his wife & son already professed faith in the Lord

Jesus Christ as savior. The other day we spoke with one of the nurses to please inform us if they have Filipino patients who would want us to assist them and pray for them. I believe this is another open door for us.
