Well, summer break has come to an end the kids are all back in school. Along with this, our feeding center is back in full operation. This marks the tenth year of our feeding center ministry. Our children's feeding program has been such a tremendous blessing over the years. Each day a hot, nutritious meal is provided for underprivileged children to help meet their physical needs. These same children, along with their parents attend our church services where their spiritual needs are met. God has used this ministry to reach families for Christ. Over the past few weeks we have seen nine adults receive Christ and five of those adults get baptized. Each of these salvations are a direct result of the feeding center program. Feeding the children gets moms and dads getting under the teaching of the Word of God... and great things happen.

Recently, we have begun projecting the Scriptures that I am teaching onto the wall behind me. After one of our services, a Ketchikan man approached me and asked if he could come by later in the week and talk. He came by two days later. When we sat down, he informed me that he was not saved and realized that he needed to trust Christ. He told me that during the Sunday message God began to speak to his heart. He said, *"It was those Scriptures on the wall that spoke to me... caused me to think about my sin. I just can't stop thinking about those Scriptures."* As I listened to him I was instantly reminded that it wasn't my preaching that moved him. It wasn't the illustration that I used or the sound of my voice. It was simply God's Word. We must never forget that God's Word is still the most powerful force in the world. The Word of God still has the power to change the hearts of men. We must do everything we can to get men and women under the sound of the Gospel... and let God do the rest. The power of the Gospel... it still works. They just need to hear it.
