
HUNTING - NETS

A <u>net</u> like this could be tied between two trees.

This net would catch birds. The birds would fly into the net and be caught in the mesh. Such a net has big holes. It is loosely woven.



Other nets were tied at one end to a tree or bush. The hunter held the other end. When the bird or animal came to eat, the hunter let go of the net. The net fell. The animal was trapped under the net.

The Bible warns us about "nets" and "snares" and "pits" that would catch us. David said of his enemies,

They have spread a net for my steps. (Psalm 57:6)

God says,

Let the wicked fall into their own net. (Psalm 141:10)
