

Larger animals were often caught in a <u>pit</u>. If a lion, bear, or leopard had been killing sheep, the men tried to find the path that this animal used. Men dug a pit (a deep hole in the ground) somewhere along this path. Then the men covered the pit with small tree branches. They might carefully pack dirt on the branches so it would look like any other part of the path.

Now the large animals comes along the path again! He steps on the thin covering of the pit. He is so heavy. Right away he breaks the covering and falls into the pit. The animal is caught.
