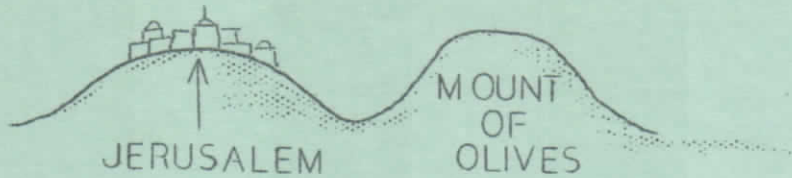


MOUNT OF OLIVES
