



Jesus often walked and talked and prayed on the Mount of Olives. Especially during the last week before His crucifixion, Jesus often came to this mountain. Here are some of the things which happened on the Mount of Olives.

## Matthew 21:1

Jesus was walking to Jerusalem with his disciples. When He came to the Mount of Olives, He sent two disciples ahead to get the donkey which He was to ride into the city. This is the day we now remember on Palm Sunday.

# Mark 11:11

Every evening during that last week Jesus walked back to the home of His friends, Mary, Martha and Lazarus. They lived in a little town called Bethany. This town is on the south and east side of the Mount of Olives. Just take the road east from Jerusalem. Walk over the Mount of Olives about 2 miles. Then you come to Bethany. Jesus walked back and forth on this road each day.

#### Mark 13:3

#### Luke 22:39

Jesus took His disciples to the Mount of Olives
to pray just before the soldiers came to arrest Him.
There is a garden close to the city of Jerusalem,
on the west side of the Mount of Olives. It is
called the Garden of Gethsemene. That night it
was dark in the garden under the trees. Peter,
James and John fell asleep. But Jesus prayed.
He knew how important it was to pray. Soon the
soldiers came to the garden. They were carrying
torches. They arrested Jesus and took Him away
to be tried and to be crucified.

### Acts 1:12 and Acts 1:9

On the third day after He was crucified, Jesus rose from the dead. For 40 days He stayed on earth, showing Himself to His disciples. Then one day when they were all together on the Mount of Olives, Jesus was taken up into heaven.
