

The anemone stand high above those flowers close to the ground. Some anemone should be red, pink, purple, and white. Make the centers black. The leaves are gray-green. The stem is green and brown.

Many anemone grow in Israel. Sometimes the ground is all covered with anemone of different colors. Often they are red and look like our poppy. But sometimes the anemone are pink, or purple-white or blue, or a creamy yellow.

Anemone have a feathery
black center. The petals are
silky. The color is clear.
They stand on strong high stems
above the shorter grass. Sometimes
the flower is 2 or 3 inches across.

Every little breeze makes these flowers flutter and dance. People in Israel call them the "windflower."

Many people think that this was the flower that Jesus said was more gayly dressed than even Solomon in all his glory.
