Introduction:

- A. If you were asked to choose the most pitiful scene after the crucifixion of Jesus, which would you choose?
 - 1. The scattered and frightened disciples...
 - 2. The caravan of weeping women who bore His body to the tomb...
 - 3. The broken-hearted Mary
 - 4. The lifeless body of Jesus taken down the cross...
 - 5. All of these are indeed sad....
- B. I think I would choose the little band of Roman soldiers standing guard at the tomb of Jesus.
 - 1. Just obeying orders....
 - 2. Just soldiers commanded to do a task...
 - 3. Just waiting three days to go home...
 - 4. Who were they?
 - a. Perhaps one was just a youth....
 - 1) Homesick for home or sweetheart...
 - 2) "I can hardly wait until this is over...
 - b. Maybe another was a scarred veterans whose many encounters with death caused him to regard life as cheap.
 - Maybe another was a soldier who for the right price would do anything and say anything.
 - 4. What were they thinking?
 - a. Or were they thinking?
 - b. Bored is probably a better word...
 - c. The tomb has been sealed...
 - d. Orders have been given to keep watch...that's all they knew...

- 5. One thing we know, never in the history of the world did soldiers have so hopeless a task....
 - a. We would laugh were it not so sad...
 - b. Unknown to them, this routine assignment was about turn into the world's most glorious day.
- 6. Two angels were winging their way from the portals of glory to declare to the world, "He is not here, for He is risen."
- C. Three voices were heard that first resurrection morning the same we hear today....
 - 1. Voice of Prejudice "He must not rise..."
 - 2. Voice of Denial "He did not rise..."
 - 3. Voice of Truth "He is risen..."

I. The Voice of Prejudice ("He must not rise...")

- A. Voice of the chief priest and Pharisees...
 - 1. They were widely separated on theology...
 - 2. Greatest difference resurrection...
 - a. Sadducees denied it...
 - b. Pharisees affirmed it...
- B. Matthew 27:62 "...they came together..."
 - 1. Why? to prevent the resurrection....
 - 2. Why would the Pharisees not want Jesus to be resurrected?
 - a. They had asked Jesus for a sign of His deity....
 - b. The sign Jesus gave was His resurrection.
 - c. The Pharisees forgot about their differences in light of their common problem....
 - 3. Jesus must not rise.....

E. So, what do we do?

- 1. Make as sure as we can that Jesus does not rise and become a living presence in our lives....
 - a. "I'm a believer, but I am not a fanatic."
 - b. So, some roll back the stone occasionally, peak in, roll it back....
 - c. On Sunday:
 - 1) Utter a prayer....
 - 2) Sing a hymn....
 - 3) Listen to a sermon...
 - 4) Seal is renewed until next Sunday...
- 2. It is almost as if we forget or do not realize the person with whom we had fellowship...
 - a. Like the disciples on the Emmaus Road...
 - b. Unconscious fellowship...
- 3. Do not close the tomb and say, "He must not rise..." The Voice of Prejudice
- 4. This morning, let Jesus become the risen Lord of your life, the source of your strength and supply of your joy....

II. The Voice of Denial

A. The Voice of the Soldiers: "He did not rise."

- 1. The soldiers ran to the chief priest ...
 - a. The chief priest took council and bribed the soldiers....
 - b. Told them to say, His disciples stole His body while they were sleeping..."
 - 1) If they were sleeping, how could they know...?
 - 2) The whole story is cut from the cloth of deceit.
- 2. The same ones who bribed and gave money to crucify Jesus, now bribe to belie His resurrection....
- B. How do you explain why these Sadducees and even modern ones, deny the resurrection?
 - 1. The Sadducees were rationalist...
 - a. If they could not reason a thing, then it could not be...
 - b. Like today's age of reasoning....
 - 2. Well, what's wrong with facts? Were there any facts in regard to Christ's resurrection?
 - a. What about all the OT prophecies?
 - b. What about the prophecy of Jesus...?
 - c. What about the occupied and sealed tomb...?
 - d. What about the soldier's report...?
 - e. What about the empty tomb, the grave cloths lying in orderly form...
 - f. What about the transformed disciples..?
 - g. What about 500 eye witnesses...?
 - 3. The Sadducees say the dead do not rise:therefore, Jesus did not rise...
 - a. The report of the soldiers...?
 - b. The empty tomb...?
 - c. The transformed disciples...?
 - d. 2000 years of Christians history....?
 - e. Changed lives...?
 - 4. Many things have to be ignored if one ignores the resurrection....
 - 5. Modern Sadducees continue to close their eyes and their hearts to the greatest truth the world has ever experienced...
 - a. Major media networks continue to run so called "documentaries" on Christ's death...

- b. Their minds are closed to truth because their hearts are closed to God...
- C. Some teach Christ's body did not rise, but that His spirit lives on in history...
 - 1. That's a round about way of saying the same thing....
 - 2. Over 300 years before Christ, Plato taught that the spirit was everything, the body nothing
 - a. The soul lived on, the body died...
 - b. Paul was combating this philosophy in I Corinthians 15 when he says that "...Christ was seen..."
 - 3. Now it is your choice:
 - a. The Sadducees or The Savior
 - b. Plato or Paul
 - c. The new age prejudice of men or the NT revelation of God.
- D. The Voice of Prejudice The Voice of Denial

III. The Voice of Truth

- A. The voice of the angel
 - 1. The religious leaders did all they could to keep the body of Jesus in the tomb....
 - a. sealed it...
 - b. set a guard about it...
 - 2. God overruled...
 - 3. The angel did not role away the stone to let Jesus out....
 - 4. The resurrected Christ is now in His glorified body....
 - a. Not subject to time....
 - b. Space...
 - c. The Roman Soldiers, Pilate, Sadducees nor Pharisees....
 - 5. Matthew 28:6
 - a. "...where he lay..."

- b. not "...where he lies..."
- B. A Living Lord means that we can live also...
 - 1. We can live spiritually...."Ye who were dead hath he quickened..."
 - 2. "Because I live ye shall live also..."
 - 3. The Bible records Jesus raising three to life again:
 - a. Jairus' daughter who had just died...
 - 1) She seem alive (just like a fresh cut flower)
 - 2) Fathers' hand is under her head...
 - 3) Mother has just kissed her rosé cheek...
 - 4) There is still a gleam in her eyes...
 - a) Youth is here today and gone tomorrow...
 - b) The results of Satan's hand upon them is just being seen...
 - c) They still look alive, yet they are dead in trespasses and sins...
 - b. The widow's son
 - 1) This young man had been dead for a while...
 - 2) Cheeks are not as rosey and signs of decay are beginning to appear.
 - 3) They are carrying his body to be buried.
 - 4) Although he looks more dead than Jarius' daughter, he is no more dead than she....
 - 5) Death knows no degrees....
 - 6) This young man is like some....
 - a) Signs of sin are beginning to show...
 - b) Satan is closing in....
 - c) Evil habits are becoming engraved...
 - c. Lazarus
 - 1) We see even greater manifestations of death...
 - 2) Martha said, "Lord, by now he stinketh..."
 - 3) Dead four days:
 - a) Yet, the young damsel, just as dead....
 - b) Yet young man, just as dead...

- 4) Someone said that Christ raised the:dead / deader / deadest
- 4. But they were all dead:
 - a. "For all have sinned and come short..."
 - b. "...even so shall all be made alive..."
- 5. Jesus said, "Because I live, ye shall live also."
- 6. The Voice of Truth "He is risen..."

Conclusion:

- A. I see modern skeptics march back and forth before a sealed tomb today:
 - 1. "God is dead...,"they say.
 - 2. "Jesus must not rise," they say.
 - 3. But these modern soldiers are to be pitted more than the Roman soldiers of old...
 - a. They left their post to declare the news of the resurrection and that Jesus was not there...
 - b. Blindly many "...professing themselves to be wise..." have become fools.
- B. Prejudice, Reason, and Deceit could not keep Jesus in the tomb and neither can it put Him back!!!!
 - 1. "He is risen..."
 - 2. Do you believe?
 - 3. Romans 10:9

9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

- D. Jesus said: (28:19-20) "GO"
