- B. David is not boasting in this psalm, though it may seem that way at times....
 - 1. He knows his integrity...
- 2. He is not asserting sinlessness before a asserting integrity before a sinful race...

- C. Verse one is a declaration of David's integrity
 - 1. He makes an appeal to heaven...
 - a. Witness what I am about to say...
 - b. God weighs what I am about to say as

being true...

- c. II Timothy 4:1
- 2 Timothy 4:1 I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;
 - d. I Thessalonians 2:10

10 Ye are witnesses, and God also, how holily and justly and unblameably we behaved ourselves among you that believe:

 - a. God is interested in character...
 - b. David's quest in life was character...
 - c. Psalm 1:1-3

Psalm 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

- 2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.
- 3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

- 3. The world is interested in what a man does; God is interested in what a man is.
- D. What is integrity?
 - 1. A heart that is not divided:
 - a. Matthew 6:24

24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

- b. Duplicity means trying to serve two masters (divided)
- c. If your eye be single then your whole body is full of light....
- d. If your eye be double, then your whole body is full of darkness....
- 2. Psalm 25:21, 26:1
 - a. When we have integrity, we do not have to worry about sliding...
 Psalm 26:1, 12
 - b. With integrity, we need not be afraid of testing to come...
- E. How did David meet this slander?
- I. He Submitted to an Honest Examination (v2)
 - A. Have you ever been eager to take a test?
 - 1. Reluctant?
 - 2. Difference? You were ready for the one...
 - B. "Lord, examine me..."
 - 1. Used of an assayer of metals...
 - 2. Make diligent search; I am not afraid for you to look.
 - 3. We often tell others, "Do not look at me. Look at Jesus."
 - 4. David says, "Look at me; see what I am

made of."

- C. Prove me, Lord / put me to the test....
 - 1. Are you sure...?

- II. He Presented A Holy Separation
 - A. The positive reasons for his confidence: (v.3)
 - 1. Faith...
 - a. David's walk was based on his trust in

- b. Faith believes God is: (Hebrews 11:6)
 - 1) Believe to see....(Psalm 27:13)
- 13 I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living. 14 Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.
 - 2) Job "the Lord gave....." (Job 1:20-22)
- 20 Then Job arose, and rent his mantle, and shaved his head, and fell down upon the ground, and worshipped,
- 21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
 - c. Weathervane –" God is Good"
 - 1) It doesn't matter which way the wind blowing.....
 - 2) Same with us...

- d. First positive is faith...
- 2. Obedience
 - a. David walked in God's truth...
 - b. "Buy the truth and sell it not..." (Proverbs 23:23)
- 23 Buy the truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding.
 - c. Eve began by adding to the truth...
 - d. There is so much falsehood today...
 - e. Reason? (John 8:44)
 - B. The negative reasons for David's confidence:
 - 1. He did not desire the fellowship of wicked men...(v.4)
 - 2. "Dissemblers" hypocritical I do not want their assistance.
 - 3. I want no part of evil doers and I do not worship their idols....(v.5)
 - 4. Psalm 1:1

Psalm 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

- C. He Submitted An Honest Examination He Presented A Holy Separation
- III. He Proclaimed A Happy Celebration (v.6-7)
 - A. Consciousness of innocence...
 - B. Praise and thanksgiving to God....
 - C. His heart is at ease concerning his actions... (I John 3:24)
- 24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.
 - D. A plea for remembrance (v.9)
 - 1. God knows what we really love in this life...
 - 2. The wicked love the congregation of evil (Psalm 1:5)

5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the

righteous.

6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

IV. He Demonstrated A Humble Determination (vs.9-12)

- A. Gather not my soul with sinners in death, because I have not had fellowship with them in life.
 - 1. Sinning has not been my practice in life...
 - 2. Violence has not followed me...
 - 3. Wicked plans have not filled my hands...
 - 4. Money has not been my goal or my god...
 - a. Job 8:20

Behold, God will not cast away a perfect man, neither will he help the evil doers:

b. Exodus 10:9

And Moses said, We will go with our young and with our old, with our sons and with our daughters, with our flocks and with our herds will we go; for we must hold a feast unto the LORD.

- B. "But as for me..."
 - 1. I will walk in mine integrity....
 - 2. "My foot standeth in an even place..."
 - a. "even" means "level."
 - 3. David will bless the Lord before the congregation.
 - a. Testify of Him...
 - b. We stand in Him and only in Him...
